

MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS

BYLAW NO. 913, 2015

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING ALLOWANCE TO PUBLIC TRAVEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26. 1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same, and

WHEREAS a public hearing was held in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, regarding Bylaw No. 913, 2015 on April 21, 2015 and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of disposing of, the following roads described in Registered Plan No. 1013526. , subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

That all roads described in Registered Plan No. as follows:

- 1. Unnamed Street on Plan 101 3526, containing 2.518 ha (6.22 acres) more or less;**
- 2. Extra Road "A" on Plan 101 3526, containing 0.141 ha (0.35 acres) more or less;**
- 3. Extra Road "B" on Plan 101 3526, containing 0.006 ha (0.01 acres) more or less;**
- 4. Walkway on Plan 101 3526, containing 0.095 ha (0.23 acres) more or less;**
- 5. Access Road on Plan 101 3526, containing 0.207 ha (0.51 acres) more or less;**
