

**MUNICIPALITY OF CROWSNEST PASS**

**BYLAW No. 890, 2014**

**Repeal of Off-Site Levy Bylaw**

A Bylaw of the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass, in the Province of Alberta, to repeal Bylaw No. 778, 2009 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass has the authority to repeal a bylaw under section 191 of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, Chapter M-26;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality has advertised its intention to consider this Bylaw pursuant to the requirements of the Municipal Government Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 778, 2009 and amendments thereto are hereby repealed

**1. General**

1.1 Nothing in this Bylaw precludes the Municipality from

a) imposing further or different levies in the future, duly enacted by bylaw, on any portion of the Developable Lands in respect of which the Municipality has the authority to collect Levies;

b) reducing, refunding, or forgiving payment of Levies paid under Bylaw No. 778, 2009 and any amendments thereto.

**2. Effective Date**

This Bylaw shall take effect and come into force effective upon the date of third and final reading.


