1.0 POLICY PURPOSE

To establish remuneration rates for Fire Rescue Personnel.

2.0 DEFINITIONS

“Fire Chief” means the duly appointed Fire Chief of the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass or designate.

“Paid On-Call” means the members of Fire Rescue that are paid when attending calls and practices.

“Standby” means the compensation that members receive to make themselves available to respond to calls.

3.0 POLICY STATEMENTS

3.1 Fire Rescue Time Sheets

- a. Fire Rescue Paid On-Call members shall submit their time at the end of each month to the Fire Chief.
- b. Time for Paid On-Call members must be submitted to the payroll department by the 10th of each month.
- c. Deposits will occur on the 15th of the month.

3.2 Payment Rates

- a. Hourly rates for attending to Fire Rescue duties including attending calls and practice shall be paid as follows:


Members \$15.00 per hour
Lieutenants \$17.50 per hour
Captains \$20.00 per hour

- b. A Fire Rescue Member may be appointed as Training Officer. All work that is performed in accordance with the Training Officer Job Description will be paid \$22.50 per hour for said work.
- c. Stand-by rate is \$2.50 per hour (\$60.00 for 24-hour period.) Time will be recorded in hours.

3.3 Fire Extinguisher Program

- a. Fire Rescue members that take on additional duties as part of the Fire Extinguisher Program shall be paid a piece rate of \$5 per unit that is serviced.
