Category 1 Grants

Who can apply

Organizations that provide the Municipality with an operational service. Examples include the museum operations and trail maintenance organizations.

Category 2 Grants

Who can apply

Organizations that co-ordinate and offer annual events and activities to the general public within the Municipality.

Category 3 Grants

Who can apply

Eligible activities for support under Category 3 Requests include the following:

- New initiatives
- Hosting of charitable events or community events of significance
- Representing the Municipality at events or provincial, national or international significance
- Other projects and activities deemed eligible by council

General information

1. Applications will be considered on a "first come, first served" basis.
2. Any funding and support approved is done so on a one-time basis.
3. Funding and support will be limited to one application per calendar year for each cause, group, organization or individual.
4. Each award of funding and support will not exceed a maximum amount of \$1,000.00 in total value (funding and in-kind support) or 50% of the total applicable costs to a maximum of \$1,000.00 – whichever amount is less.

Family & Community Support Services Grants

Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) is a partnership between the Province and the Municipality that develops locally driven preventative social initiatives to enhance the well-being of individuals, families and communities.

Each year Crowsnest Pass FCSS allocated a substantial amount of funds (\$103,500 in 2018) to local organizations and programs.

FCSS currently has two types of Funding

Category 1

Funding requests made during the Fall Grant Application Intake. Funding is for the following years programs/projects. No maximum

Category 2

Funding requests made throughout the year to a maximum amount of \$1000 per year. Category 2 Funding will be made available to the community throughout the year. Applications will be considered on a "first come, first serve" basis and will be limited one per year per applicant.
