Participation Process

Cafe Style

Participants will be seated at tables and challenged with envisioning ideas that would support the beautification of the Crowsnest Pass. Specific categories will be assigned to each table, and a scribe will be provided to record ideas. Participants will then be given the opportunity to review the ideas generated by the other tables and to add ideas of their own. In addition to the specific table topics, there will be the opportunity to explore ideas not noted in the pre-assigned table topics.



Walkabout

Participants will be given the opportunity to choose their top priorities on the ideas generated in the Cafe by reviewing them all and assigning value to each. Once the top priorities are established, action items will be identified and participants will work to identify any resources required to make them happen.



Community Survey

The Parks and Recreation Authority and staff will review the information gathered from the facilitated session in conjunction with the consultant and develop a number of questions for the community to confirm the values, wants, and needs.

Report

A report will be developed to capture all of the information generated.
