### FireSmart Program

- We work with home owners, businesses and government through education and vegetation management to help lessen the effects of wildfire.
- Wildland Urban Interface - Where the urban lifestyle meets environments that are prone to wildfire such as in our community



### Wildland Firefighting

- We actively participate with our emergency response partners in training, wildfire preparedness and in responding to wildfire type incidents.
- In 2017, Crowsnest Pass Fire Rescue members worked tirelessly to extinguish a large wildfire that began on the west end of our municipality, as a direct result they saved homes and businesses threatened in our community.

### Emergency Response

- Crowsnest Pass Fire Rescue is committed to providing professional and rapid Emergency Response to our community. We respond to calls for service 24 hours per day, 365 days per year for Structural Firefighting, Rescue, Motor Vehicle Incidents, Disaster Response and Relief.
- Crowsnest Pass Fire Rescue has mutual aid agreements with our neighbours to help respond to larger events.
- In 2017, we answered 168 Calls For service!
