

Re: Municipal Inspection, Municipality of Crowsnest Pass
Explanatory Notes

The undersigned parties wish to provide an explanatory note on the report created from the 2013 Municipal Inspection on the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass.

On Page twenty-nine (29) of the report there is a paragraph which describes the municipality's efforts to implement Automated Traffic Enforcement. This paragraph was intended to illustrate a program delivery and budgeting issue which a Councillor identified to the inspector as adversely impacting the relationship between Council and administration.


This paragraph references a report produced by an un-named consultant. We wish to clarify that it was not within the scope of the Municipal Inspection to critically assess the work of consultants or contractors previously engaged by the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass. A critical review of the work of this or other contracted resources was not completed. As a result, the Inspection report should not be seen, in any way, as a comment on the quality of the work of this or any other consultant or contracted resource previously engaged by the municipality.
