



PASS POWDERKEG SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, this position serves to assist with summer maintenance operations, groundskeeping and other tasks related to Pass Powderkeg Ski Area's operation plan. This position is eligible only for students who have attended post-secondary school throughout the past year and intend to return to post secondary school in the upcoming fall.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Mow and weed whip cleared ski runs and lift lines
- Clear logs and branches off runs
- Spray and pull noxious weeds on Pass Powderkeg land
- Paint buildings and lift towers
- Assist in creation and improvement of lift operations manuals, policies and procedures
- Clear deadfall from treed areas
- Assist with maintaining spring boxes, lift towers and safety systems
- Operate all equipment and tools in a safe manner
- Assist with other jobs on an as needed basis.

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills

- Mechanical aptitude and understanding of basic operations and maintenance of equipment.
- Basic understanding of mountain resort maintenance and ski / snowboarding terrain needs.
- Self motivated, able to work independently
- Requires physical aptitude to clear runs
- Ability to communicate effectively

Working Conditions

- Must be able to work flexible hours, including evening or night shifts
- Must be physically capable of operating and maintaining equipment
- This role will be exposed for brief periods to extreme weather conditions (snow, wind, cold) in isolated areas.

This position requires someone who has attended post-secondary school full time in the prior school year and will be returning to school in the fall

This is an hourly position beginning early May and running until the end of August, depending on availability.
