

A Prairie Urban Garden is a yard or garden that follows the 7 principles of xeriscaping. They are attractive and have a low environmental impact because they are designed and maintained in harmony with our dry prairie environment. Xeriscaping principles allow people to create beautiful, drought tolerant and low maintenance gardens right here in southern Alberta!

The 7 principles of xeriscaping are:

- 1. Plan and design
- 2. Improve the soil
- 3. Create practical turf areas
- 4. Water efficiently
- 5. Choose appropriate plant
- 6. Use mulch
- 7. Maintain your xeriscape

### BROWN-EYED SUSAN OR BLANKET FLOWER -

(Gaillardia aristata)

A self-sowing native flower that grows in

clumps.

**Height:** 60-76cm (24-30") **Spread:** 30-46cm (12-18")

Flower colour: Yellow or yellow with

burgundy.

Flowering period: Mid-summer to fall.

Deadhead to prolong flowering.

**Habitat:** Full sun. Well drained soils. **Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every few

years to maintain plant vigor.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or general plant nurseries.



### **DOTTED BLAZING STAR** – (Liatris punctata)

A tall flower sometimes called gayfeather.

**Height:** 30-76cm (12-30") **Spread:** 30-45cm (12-18")

**Flower colour:** Pinkish purple or white. **Flowering period:** Late summer to early

fall.

Habitat: Full sun. Well drained dry soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every few

years to maintain plant vigor.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

general plant nurseries.

# PURPLE CONEFLOWER – (Echinacea angustifolia)

Several cultivars of this flower are commonly available.

Height: 45-70cm (18-28") Spread: 45-60cm (18-24")

Flower colour: Purplish pink.

**Flowering period:** Mid-summer to mid fall. Deadhead to prolong flowering.

Habitat: Full sun to very light shade. Well

drained soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every few years to maintain plant vigor.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or seasonal





### WILD BERGAMOT – (Monarda fistulosa)

Has a lemon-mint aroma and is sometimes called bee balm.

**Height:** 38-76cm (15-30") **Spread:** 45-60cm (18-24")

**Flower colour:** Purple, pink or red. **Flowering period:** Mid to late summer.

Habitat: Prefers dry to moist, well

drained soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Allow for air circulation around it. Clip off leaves infected with powdery mildew. Divide every 4-5 years to maintain plant vigor and prevent overcrowding.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



SHOWY JACOB'S LADDER – (Polemonium pulcherrimum)

An early bloomer that self-sows.

**Height:** 20-60cm (8-24") **Spread:** 30-45cm (12-18")

Flower colour: Purplish blue with yellow

centre.

**Flowering period:** Mid spring to early summer and late summer to early fall. Deadhead to prolong flowering.

**Habitat:** Full sun to moderate shade. Dry

to moist soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Allow room for expansion because self-sowing.

Availability: Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



#### THREADLEAF TICKSEED OR MOONBEAM

TICKSEED – (Coreopsis verticillata, Coreopsis verticillata cv. 'Moonbeam')

Native cultivars with fine textured foliage.

**Height:** 30-45cm (12-18") **Spread:** 30-45cm (12-18") **Flower colour:** Yellow.

**Flowering period:** Peaks in early to midsummer but continues in fall.

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Poor to

average well drained soils.

Maintenance: Clip to ground level in

March before green up.

Availability: General plant nurseries or

seasonal garden centres.

## SPIKE SPEEDWELL – (Veronica spicata)

Non-native that is also available in a creeping form.

**Height:** 40-45cm (16-18") **Spread:** 30-45cm (12-18")

**Flower colour:** Blue, purple, pink or red.

**Flowering period:** Peaks in early to midsummer but continues in fall.

**Habitat:** Full sun to moderate shade.

Well drained, dry to moist soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every 3-4 years to maintain vigor and reduce crowding.

**Availability:** General plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



#### PRAIRIE CONEFLOWER OR MEXICAN HAT -

(Ratibida columnifera)

A native flower with a tap root. **Height:** 30-60 cm (12-24") **Spread:** 30-45 cm (12-18")

Flower colour: Yellow.

Flowering period: Early July to mid

August.

Habitat: Full sun. Dry loamy to gravelly

soils.

Maintenance: Clip to ground level in

March before green up.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or seasonal

garden centres.

### AUTUMN JOY SEDUM OR SHOWY STONECROP

- (Sedum spectabile) 'Autumn Joy'

A non-native hybrid that flowers into the fall.

**Height:** 45-60cm (18-24") **Spread:** 45-60cm (18-24")

Flower colour: Pink, deepens to red in

fall.

Flowering period: Late summer-early

fall.

**Habitat:** Full sun to light shade. Will tolerate sandy, rocky or gravelly soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every 3-4 years to maintain vigor and reduce crowding.

**Availability:** General plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



#### ROUND-LEAVED OR RICHARDSON'S ALUMROOT

- (Heuchera cylindrica) and (Heuchera richardsonii)

Also known as coral bells and available in a wide range of cultivars.

**Height:** 7-8cm (18-20") **Spread:** 3-4cm (8-10")

Flower colour: Creamy or pink.

**Flowering period:** Early to mid summer.

**Habitat:** Full sun to light shade. Well drained, sandy, gravelly or rocky soils.

**Maintenance:** Clip to ground level in March before green up. Divide every 3-4

years to maintain vigor.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers or

general plant nurseries.



### LIMBER PINE - (Pinus flexilis)

Evergreen tree with blue-green needles and brown cones.

Height: 8-9m (26-30')

**Spread:** 5m (16')

Habitat: Full sun. Well drained, rocky

soils.

**Maintenance:** Low. Do not try to change

uneven silhouette.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

general plant nurseries.



## COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE – (Picea pungens)

Evergreen tree with blue to bluish-green needles and brown cones.

**Height:** 30cm-20m (12"-26') **Spread:** 60cm-8m (2'-26')

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well

drained soils.

Maintenance: Low. Pruning may be

required only to tidy it up.

Availability: Widely available.

### WHITE SPRUCE - (Picea glauca)

Evergreen tree with green needles.

Height: 18m (59') **Spread:** 6m (20')

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well

drained soils.

Maintenance: Low.

Availability: Widely available.



ROUND-LEAVED HAWTHORN - (Crataegus chrysocarpa or Crataegus rotundifolia)

Small tree with white or pink flowers in spring and prominent thorns.

Height: 5m (16') **Spread:** 4m (13')

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well

drained soils

Maintenance: Low. Does not require any significant pruning to maintain its shape.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers or

general plant nurseries.



## AMUR MAPLE - (Acer ginnala)

Small deciduous tree that produces red fruit in fall

**Height:** 5-6m (16-20') **Spread:** 3-4m (10-13')

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Dry to

moist soils.

**Maintenance:** Once trained as a tree it will not need any significant pruning to

maintain its rounded canopy.

**Availability:** General plant nurseries and seasonal garden centres.



# GREEN ASH OR RED ASH — (Fraxinus pennsylvanica)

Large deciduous tree with oval canopy.

Height: 15m (49')

**Spread:** 8-10m (26-33')

Habitat: Full sun to very light shade. Well

drained soils are preferred.

**Maintenance:** Low. Tree must be provided adequate space to reach full maturity.

Availability: General plant nurseries and

seasonal garden centres.



## **BLACK CHOKECHERRY** – (Prunus virginiana

var. melanocarpa)

Small to medium sized deciduous tree with white flowers in spring.

**Height:** 7.6m (25') **Spread:** 4.6m (15')

**Habitat:** Full sun. Well drained soils. **Maintenance:** Requires some regular

care and attention.

Availability: General plant nurseries and

seasonal garden centres.



### **BUR OAK** – (Quercus macrocarpa)

Large deciduous tree that produces acorns.

Height: 15m (49') Spread: 12m (39')

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well

drained soils.

**Maintenance:** Low. Tree must be provided adequate space to reach full

maturity.



# **SWEDISH COLUMNAR ASPEN** – (Populus tremula 'Erecta')

Tall, narrow deciduous tree perfect for creating privacy.

Height: 9-12m (30-39')

**Spread:** 2m (7')

**Habitat:** Full sun. Well drained soils. **Maintenance:** Low. Fast growing.

Availability: General plant nurseries and

seasonal garden centres.



# WESTERN MOUNTAIN ASH – (Sorbus scopulina)

Medium sized tree with clusters of white flowers in spring.

**Height:** 5.5-10m (18-33')

**Spread:** 5m (16')

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Grows

in most soils.

Maintenance: Low. Produces orange

berries.

Availability: Native plant suppliers.

# FLOWERING CRABAPPLE – (Malus x astringens cultivars)

Small deciduous trees with white, red or pink flowers.

Height: 5.5-10m (18-33')

**Spread:** 5m (16')

Habitat: Full sun. Well drained soils.

Maintenance: Moderate. Pruning is best

done late in winter.

Availability: General plant nurseries and

seasonal garden centres.



### NINEBARK – (Physocarpos opulifolius)

Large shrub with several leaf colour options.

Height: 1.8–2.4m (6–8') Spread: 1.8–2.4m (6–8')

Flower Colour: White.

**Foliage Colour:** Burgundy, copperyorange, purplish-red, golden-green.

Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Dry to

moist, loam to sandy soils.

Maintenance: Low. Prune after

flowering.

Availability: Plant nurseries or seasonal

garden centres.



SHRUBBY CINQUEFOIL – (Dasiphora floribunda or Potentilla fruticosa)

Low shrub with irregular branches.

**Height:** 60cm-1.2m (24"-4') **Spread:** 90cm-1.2m (36"-4')

Flower Colour: Native - yellow. Cultivars

- white, orange, pink or yellow.

Foliage Colour: Green leaves.

Flowering Period: June – September

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well-

drained loam to sandy soils.

Maintenance: Low. Prune after

flowering.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or seasonal

garden centres.



### MUGO PINE - (Pinus mugo)

Variable species that can be a dwarf sized shrub, large shrub or small tree.

Height: 60cm-3.7m (24"-12')

Spread: 90cm-2.0m (36"-6'6")

Flower Colour: Brown cones.

Foliage Colour: Green needles.

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Well-

drained loam to sandy soils.

Maintenance: Low. Prune late May -

early June.

**Availability:** Seasonal garden centres for large, general plant nursery for dwarf.



# THORNY BUFFALOBERRY OR SILVER BUFFALOBERRY – (Shepherdia argentea)

A native shrub with edible fruit.

**Height:** 2.6m (8'6") **Spread:** 2.6m (8'6")

Flower Colour: Yellow. Red berries in

late summer.

Flowering Period: Early spring.

**Foliage Colour:** Grey-green to silver. **Habitat:** Full sun. Very well-drained loam

or sandy soils.

Maintenance: Minimal pruning. Tends to

sucker.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

general plant nurseries.



## **BLUE JUNIPER** – (Juniperus scopulorum)

An evergreen that comes in several sizes.

**Height:** 3–6m (10-20')

**Spread:** 90cm-1.8m (36"-6')

Flower Colour: Bluish-white, berry-like.
Foliage Colour: Blue to bluish-green

needles.

**Habitat:** Full sun. Well drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. **Maintenance:** Low. Prune late May –

early June.

**Availability:** Native – uncommon. Cultivars - general plant nurseries or

seasonal garden centres.



### GOLDEN CURRANT - (Ribes aureum)

A native medium sized shrub with edible

fruit.

**Height**: 1.8m (6') **Spread**: 1.8m (6')

Flower Colour: Yellow.

Flowering Period: Mid-spring.

**Foliage Colour:** Green. Orange in fall. **Habitat:** Full sun to partial shade. Welldrained loam, sandy, or gravelly soil.

Maintenance: Low. Prune during

summer after flowering.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers and nurseries or general plant nurseries.



# SKUNKBRUSH, LEMONADE SUMAC OR THREE-LOBED SUMAC — (Rhus trilobata)

Native shrub whose fruit can be used to make lemonade.

**Height:** 90cm - 1.5m (36"-5') **Spread:** 90cm - 1.5m (36"-5') **Flower Colour:** Pale yellow.

Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

Foliage Colour: Dark green.

Habitat: Full sun. Well-drained soil.

Maintenance: Low. No pruning required.

Extremely drought tolerant.

Availability: Native plant suppliers and

nurseries.



## SOAPWEED OR YUCCA – (Yucca glauca)

Unique, native shrub.

Height: 60cm-90cm (24-36")

Spread: 60cm-90cm (24-36")

Flower Colour: Creamy-white.

Flowering Period: June – July.

Foliage Colour: Bluish-green with

narrow white edge.

Habitat: Full sun. Well-drained sandy or

rocky coarse-textured soils.

**Maintenance:** Minimal once established. **Availability:** Native plant suppliers and nurseries, some general plant nurseries.



RED OSIER DOGWOOD - (Cornus sericea or

Cornus stolonifera)

Large, native shrub that is highly

adaptable.

Height: 3.0m (10')

Spread: 3.0m (10')

Flower Colour: White.

Flowering Period: Late spring.
Foliage Colour: Green and white variegated leaves. Red or yellow bark.
Habitat: Full sun to partial shade.

Availability: Native plant suppliers and

nurseries, general plant nurseries.

Maintenance: Low. Light pruning.

### SILVER SAGEBRUSH – (Artemisia cana)

Native, evergreen shrub that smalls like

sage.

**Height:** 60–120cm (2-4') **Spread:** 60–120cm (2-4') Flower Colour: Yellow.

Flowering Period: August – September.

Foliage Colour: Silver.

Habitat: Full sun. Well-drained loam or

sandy soils.

Maintenance: Limited pruning of old

wood to improve vigor.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers and

nurseries.



### **BLUE GRAMA GRASS** – (Bouteloua gracilis)

Native grass with distinct eyelash shaped

flowers

Height: 30-45cm (12") **Spread:** 30cm (12")

Flower colour: Burgundy – purple at

maturity; green in early season.

Foliage colour: Short curly green

leaves.

Flowering period: Mid to late summer. Habitat: Full sun, shade intolerant. Well

drained soils.

Maintenance: When used as sod. mow no lower than 10 cm (4"). When not mowed, cut back to 15 cm (6") in spring.

**Availability:** Native plant suppliers. When used as sod replacement, should be purchased as seed and sown at 1.8 kg/93 m<sup>2</sup> (4 lbs/1000 ft<sup>2</sup>). Plugs also

# FEATHER REED GRASS – (Calamagrostis acutiflora)

Attractive, tall grass great for adding vertical interest.

**Height:** 90–100cm (36 – 39")

**Spread:** 45cm (18")

Flower Colour: Pink – purple in early

season, light brown as it matures.

Foliage Colour: Long, green leaves.

Flowering Period: Early to midsummer.

**Habitat:** Full sun to partial shade.

Tolerates all soils.

Maintenance: Clip 1/3 of its height in



**BLUE OATGRASS** – (Helictotrichon sempervirens)

Non-native grass with vivid blue foliage.

Height: 100cm (39")

**Spread:** 30–45cm (12–18") **Flower Colour:** Light brown.

Foliage Colour: Silver-blue to steel blue. Flowering Period: Early to midsummer.

Habitat: Full sun to very light sun.

Requires well drained soils, will rot in wet

soils.

Maintenance: Clip 1/3 of its height in

spring before green up.

Availability: General plant nurseries or

seasonal garden centres.

## **SWITCH GRASS** – (Panicum virgatum)

Native grass that is admired for its color change over the growing season.

Height: 120-150cm (47-59") **Spread:** 60–90cm (24–36")

Flower colour: Green or burgundy.

Foliage colour: Start as green with red tinge, switching to red or burgundy over

growing season.

Flowering Period: Late summer.

Habitat: Full sun. Likes moist, clay soil

but tolerant of dry soil.

Maintenance: Clip 15 cm (6") in spring before green-up and remove litter from base.

Availability: Native plant suppliers, general plant nurseries or some seasonal.





### IDAHO FESCUE – (Festuca idahoensis)

Native grass best grouped in clusters.

Height: 90cm (36") **Spread:** 25cm (10")

Flower colour: Green to tan coloured as

it matures.

Foliage colour: Bluish-green. Flowering period: June-July.

Habitat: Full sun. Well drained soil. **Maintenance:** Clip 1/3 of its height in

spring before green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers.

JUNEGRASS – (Koeleria macrantha, Koeleria gracilis, Koeleria pyrmidata)

Native grass that is very hardy.

**Height:** 45cm (18") **Spread:** 30cm (12")

Flower colour: Green. Matures to straw-

tan colour.

Foliage Colour: Greenish-blue.

Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

Habitat: Full sun. Tolerates poor soil of

all types if well drained.

Maintenance: Clip 1/3 of its height in

spring before green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or



## PRAIRIE DROPSEED - (Sporobolus

heterolepis)

Native grass that adds colour in fall.

**Height:** 60–90cm (24–36") **Spread:** 50–60cm (20–24")

Flower Colour: Pink with hints of brown.

Foliage Colour: Deep green, through maturity they become golden with shades

of orange and pink.

Flowering Period: August – September. Habitat: Full sun. Dry, rocky locations. Maintenance: Clip back to 15 cm (6") in spring before green up. Clear decayed plant material from base in spring.

**Availability:** Seed available or mail order

plugs/containers.

## **NEEDLE AND THREAD** – (Stipa comate)

Native grass with long thread like seeds.

**Height:** 45cm (18") **Spread:** 30cm (12")

Flower Colour: Distinct green which turns to light brown as it matures.

Foliage Colour: Light green.

Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

**Habitat:** Full sun. Very well drained soil. **Maintenance:** Clip back to 15 cm (6") in

spring before green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

mail order.



# LITTLE BLUESTEM – (Schizachyrium scoparium)

Native grass that adds colour in fall.

Height: 90cm (36")

Spread: 30cm (12")

Flower Colour: Pinkish.

**Foliage Colour:** Light green with bluish tinge that changes to rusty-orange or

pinkish-red in fall.

Flowering Period: August – September. Habitat: Full sun. Well drained soils. Maintenance: Clip back to 15 cm (6") in

spring before green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

mail order.



# INDIAN RICEGRASS – (Achatherum hymenoides)

A slow growing but very showy native grass.

**Height:** 50–70cm (20–28") **Spread:** 30–45cm (12–18")

Flower Colour: Green turning to

straw/tan colour.

Foliage Colour: Green.

Flowering Period: Late spring.

Habitat: Full sun. Well drained gravelly

soils.

Maintenance: Clip back to 15 cm (6") in

spring before green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

mail order.



#### KINNIKINNICK OR BEARBERRY -

(Arctostaphylos uva-ursi)

Native, trailing evergreen with red fruit.

**Height:** 20-30cm (8-12") **Spread:** 60-90cm (2-3')

Foliage Colour: Pinkish to white.

Foliage Colour: Dark green.

Flowering Period: Spring.

Habitat: Full sun to partial shade. Well-

drained, sandy acidic soils. **Maintenance:** Minimal.

Availability: Native plant suppliers and

nurseries.



PINK OR ROSY PUSSY-TOES — (Antennaria rosea or Antennaria microphylla)

Mat forming native perennial perfect for rock gardens.

Height: 10-15cm (4-6")

Spread: 30cm (12")

Flower Colour: Pink or creamy white.

Foliage Colour: Silvery-green.

Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

Habitat: Full sun. Dry, well-drained soils.

Poor soil conditions.

Maintenance: Minimal.

Availability: Native plant suppliers and

nurseries.



HENS AND CHICKS - (Sempervivum spp.)

Mat forming non-native perennial with many colour options.

Height: 7-15cm (3-6")

**Spread:** 30–60cm (12-24")

Flower Colour: Red, pink, yellow, purple

or white.

Foliage Colour: Green, greenish-blue,

purple, red.

Flowering Period: Summer.

Habitat: Full sun. Well-drained, poor

soils.

Maintenance: Very low.

Availability: General plant nurseries or



#### 45 • GROUND COVERS

STONECROP - (Sedum spp.)

Forms a dense mat of colourful flowers.

**Height:** 5-25 cm (2-10") **Spread:** 30-60 cm (12-24")

Flower Colour: Yellow, pink or rose.
Foliage Colour: Green, bluish-green,

red or purple.

Flowering Period: Early spring.

Habitat: Full sun. Very well-drained loam

or sandy soils.

**Maintenance:** Minimal pruning. Tends to

sucker.

**Availability:** Native - Native plant suppliers and nurseries. Cultivars – General plant nurseries or seasonal

garden centres.



#### CREEPING AND COMMON JUNIPER -

(Juniperus horizontalis & Juniperus communis)

Low, spreading evergreen that needs to maintenance.

Height: 10-30cm (4-12")

**Spread:** 1- 2.5m (3-8')

**Foliage Colour:** Green, blue, chartreuse, golden- yellow, silver-blue or bluish-green.

Habitat: Full sun, tolerance to partial

shade. Well drained soils.

Maintenance: Low. No pruning if right

size species selected.

**Availability:** Native- Native plant suppliers & nurseries. Cultivars and nonnative- General plant nurseries or season

garden centres.



MOSS PHLOX OR CREEPING PHLOX – (Phlox subulata)

Forms a dense mound with abundant flowers in spring.

**Height:** 5-15 cm (2-6") **Spread:** 30-45 cm (12-18")

Flower Colour: Pink, lavender, red, pale

blue or white.

Flowering Period: May to June.

Foliage Colour: Green, needle-like.

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Dry, well-

drained soils.

Maintenance: Low. Trim 1/3 of foliage in

late winter or early spring.

**Availability:** Native – not available. Cultivars - common to general plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



#### **WESTERN YARROW** – (Achillia millefolium)

Spreading flower that prefers hot, dry areas.

**Height:** 70cm (27") **Spread:** 60cm (24")

Flower Colour: White, yellow, rose or

red.

Flowering Period: Early to late summer.

Foliage Colour: Green.

Habitat: Prefers full sun, tolerant of

partial shade.

**Maintenance:** Moderate. Cut back in spring before green up. Deadhead to extend flowering. Requires containment.

Availability: Native- native plant suppliers. Cultivars- general plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



### **THYME** – (Thymus spp.)

A minty smelling plant that will tolerate foot traffic.

**Height:** 2.5–15cm (1–6") **Spread:** 15-60cm (6-24")

Flower Colour: Purple, pink or white.
Flowering Period: Late spring to early

summer.

**Foliage Colour:** Green or variegated green with white or yellow highlights.

Habitat: Full sun. Poor to average, well-

drained soil.

Maintenance: After flowering cut back

1/3.

**Availability:** General plant nurseries or seasonal garden centres.



# LAMIUM, DEADNETTLE OR SPOTTED DEADNETTLE — (Lamium maculatum)

A great option for shady spots around trees.

**Height:** 15–30 cm (6-12") **Spread:** 30-60 cm (12-24")

Flower Colour: Pink, purple or white. Flowering Period: Late spring to late

summer.

Foliage Colour: Deep green, silver or

variegated.

Habitat: Full shade.

Maintenance: Low. Trim to keep tidy.

Requires containment.

Availability: General plant nurseries or

seasonal garden centres.

# THREE-FLOWERED AVENS, PRAIRIE SMOKE, OR OLD MAN'S WHISKERS — (Geum triflorum)

A unique flower with fern like leaves.

Height: 60cm (24") **Spread:** 30cm (12")

Flower Colour: Pinky red.

Flowering Period: Late spring to mid-

summer.

Foliage Colour: Blue-green.

Habitat: Full sun to light shade. Well

drained, loamy to sandy soils.

Maintenance: Low. Cut back to ground level in late winter or early spring before

green up.

Availability: Native plant suppliers or

some general plant nurseries.
