- Geomarketing campaign on YouTube to promote relocate to Crowsnest Pass
 - o The relocation video had 245,00 views
 - Patrick showed the "Relocate to Adventure" video to the committee, which will likely be promoted again for April and May
- Pass Powderkeg has been the primary winter campaign
- Calgary Adventure Show March 18-19, 2023
 - Committee members were requested to consider being Ambassadors to represent the Municipality at the Calgary Adventure Show
