**1. PREAMBLE**

The Municipality of Crowsnest Pass is replacing three (3) light duty trucks in the Operational Services fleet. These units will be utilized for multi-functional municipal operational tasks for the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass. This Call for Tender is for the supply of one (1) ¾ ton regular cab 4x4 long box, one (1) - 1 ton 4 x 4 regular cab chassis truck, and one (1) 2-ton 4 x 4 crew cab chassis. The Municipality's Operations Department has evaluated different types of light duty trucks and has determined that these specifications are best suited for the Municipality's needs in safety, quality, performance, and standardization. This specification is not to be interpreted as restrictive, but rather as a measure of the safety, quality and performance against which all bids will be compared. In comparing proposals, consideration will not be confined to price only. The successful bidder will be one whose product is judged shall best serve the interests of the Municipality when price, product, safety, quality and delivery are considered. The Municipality of Crowsnest Pass reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part thereof, and to waive any minor technicalities. A contract will be awarded to the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid meeting the requirements of this specification.

**2. INFORMATION TO BIDDERS**

The following information provides bidders with required specifications. Bidders are required to complete documents accurately and in entirety. Bidders are expected to carefully examine all information and satisfy themselves of conditions of the tender requirements. Faxed bids will not be accepted. Tendered bid must include all of the following:

- i) Cost of delivery to Operational Services – Blairmore Shop, (12525 – 21 Ave, Blairmore AB)
- ii) Cost of any applicable options included
- iii) All taxes, levies, fees and charges
- iv) Any other costs associated with purchase

Bids, labeled "2019 Light Trucks" will be accepted at the Crowsnest Pass Municipal Office located at 8502 - 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Coleman until 2:00 pm on Thursday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

Pages 12 and 13 are considered the bid sheets and must be filled out in their entirety and signed off by an authorized bidder representative.

#### **4. EQUIVALENT PRODUCT**

Bids will be accepted for consideration on any make or model that is equal or superior to the trucks specified. Decisions of equivalency will be at the sole interpretation of the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass's Operations Department. A blanket statement that equipment proposed will meet all requirements will not be sufficient to establish equivalence. Original manufacturer's brochures of the proposed unit are to be submitted with the proposal.

All modifications made to the standard production unit described in the manufacturer's brochures must be certified by the manufacturer and submitted with the bid, or the bid will be deemed "non-responsive" and rejected without further review. Bidder must be prepared to demonstrate a unit similar to the one proposed, if requested.

#### **5. INTERPRETATIONS**

In order to be fair to all bidders, no oral interpretations will be given to any bidder as to the meaning of the specification documents or any part thereof. Every request for such a consideration shall be made in writing to the Operations Administrative Assistant. Based upon such inquiry, the Municipality may choose to issue an Addendum.

#### **6. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

The undersigned also understands and agrees as follows:

6.1. The Municipality of Crowsnest Pass reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders and to waive irregularities and informalities at its discretion. The Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender other than the lowest priced bid without stating reasons. By the act of submitting a tendered bid, the bidder waives any right to contest in any legal proceeding or action the right of the Municipality to award the tender to whomever it chooses, in its sole and unfettered discretion, and for whatever reasons the Municipality deems appropriate. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Municipality may consider any other factor besides price and ability to supply product that it deems in its sole discretion to be relevant to its decision including but not limited to the following.

6.1.1. Any past experience with the company, organization or firm acting as the bidder, or lack thereof;

6.1.2. The results of any reference check done by the Municipality;

6.1.3. Information relating to the financial state of the company, organization or firm representing the bidder, however obtained.

6.2. If a bidder whose tender is accepted by the municipality refuses or fails within thirty (30) days; after a contract is offered to them for acceptance to execute the terms of the accepted tender, the bidder shall be liable to the Municipality of Crowsnest Pass for the amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the accepted tender price.

#### **7. SPECIFICATIONS**

- Add all the specifications met
- Divide that number by total number of specifications in Section 7.0
- Multiply that number by 20

Dealer warranty & parts availability:

- Based on what warranty is offered – please list in quote (Base used is 3 years Bumper to Bumper)
- Parts availability (Base used is 1-day availability)
- Minus each year less than 3 or each day more than 5

Delivery Time:

- Base is 6 weeks from award of tender
- If less than 6 weeks, then 15
- Divide number of weeks by 6
